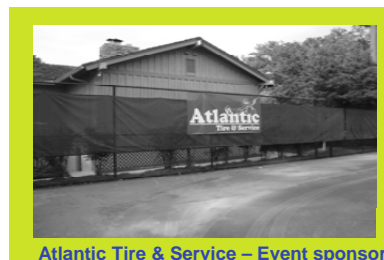

Share in a memorable evening as we honor Andy Andrews, NC State All-American, Final 8 Club member of the U.S. Open and Australian Open and member of the NC Tennis Hall of Fame.

The fun-filled evening will include cocktails, dinner, an exhibition match, silent auction and live entertainment.

Andy earned All-America honors in doubles (twice) and singles while at NC State and posted 75 career victories in singles, 2nd in school history. During his years on the pro tour, Andy won 17 professional titles in singles and doubles. Partnering with State teammate, John Sadri, he reached the finals of the Australian Open and the Semifinals of the U.S. Open in 1983.

Retired now from tennis, Andy continues to passionately serve the tennis community. He volunteers on numerous charitable boards and led the fundraising drives for State's J.W. Isenhour Tennis Center and the NC Tennis Association Endowment Fund.

Andy serves as CEO and President of Dominion Realty Partners, LLC and resides in Raleigh with wife Carol, daughter Rhyne and son Bo.
